**Acts 3:11-26**

## **I. We must give glory to Jesus Christ.**

A. We must not seek the glory for ourselves.

B. We must tell people who He is and what He has done.

1.) We must tell people who He is:

- “the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth” (vv. 6, 16)
- “his servant”(v. 13)
- “the Holy and Righteous One” (v. 14)
- “the Author of life” (v. 15)
- “his Christ” (v. 18)
- “the prophet” (vv. 22-23)
- offspring of Abraham (v. 25)

2.) We must tell people what He has done:

- He died on the cross. (v. 15)
- “that His Christ would suffer” (v. 18)
- He was raised from the dead. (v. 15)
- He is in heaven. (v. 21)
- He is coming back again and to judge all who have rejected Him. (vv. 19-23)

## **II. We must help people realize they are sinners and warn them of God’s judgment to come.**

**Acts 3:14-15 (ESV)** <sup>14</sup> But you denied the Holy and Righteous One, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, <sup>15</sup> and you killed the Author of life, whom God raised from the dead. To this we are witnesses.

**John 15:22 (ESV)** If I had not come and spoken to them, they would not have been guilty of sin, but now they have no excuse for their sin.

**Acts 3:23 (ESV)** ‘And it shall be that every soul who does not listen to that prophet shall be destroyed from the people.’

## **III. We must show people their need for repentance.**

**Acts 3:19 (ESV)** Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out,
